

Bills on the Move

Signed by the Governor

UDAAP Chapter Amendments ([A9444](#) Lasher/[S8811](#) Comrie) Expands the powers of the attorney general to enforce unfair, deceptive, and abusive acts and practices. **Signed chapter 94 of the laws of 2026.**

AI Transparency Chapter Amendments ([A9449](#) Bores/[S8828](#) Gounardes). Relates to the training and use of artificial intelligence frontier models. **Signed chapter 96 of the laws of 2026.**

Passed Assembly

Arbitration Decision Publication ([A3318](#) Dinowitz/[S926](#) Kavanagh) Requires private arbitration organizations involved in fifty or more consumer arbitrations per year to collect, publish at least quarterly, and make available to the public in a computer-searchable database certain information relating to such arbitrations. **NYIA Opposes.**

Ban on Lead Paint Exclusions ([A1067](#) Rivera) Prohibits the exclusion of coverage for losses or damages caused by exposure to lead-based paint. **NYIA Opposes.**

- No Senate corresponding bill.
